nighttime performance, suitable for all audiences, capacity: 10,000 people,
team of 26 Plasticiens Volants + 15 local collaborators.

At the beginning the Earth was bare,
the animals lived free of all human presence.
A nonchalant tropical fish flies over the audience,
while a puffin hovers around giant plants.





Then the colonists arrive by ship,
their ship flies over the square,
spheres made of multiple faces are on board, they also fly.

On the ground, about fifteen characters,
“the small people” follow the movement, their nose up in the air,
climbing on all the elements that allow them to see further,
searching for a suitable place for them to settle.
Some are wearing colorful houses on their backs.

It's a group composed of volunteers which we include to the show.

An exceptional experience for them to discover
with us the emotions of street theater.







Finally arrived,

It's the birth of a village.

The boat leaves.

The spheres with faces begin an industrial choreography,
echoing the movements of "the small people", on the ground.

The activity becomes frantic.

Enormous heads with their gobs wide open
appear at the feet of the chimneys which are building up,
we call them the Molochs.

The workers are attracted, then swallowed by these monsters,
like the image of the factory in Metropolis by Fritz Lang.

The Molochs swallow the "small people",
then the spheres with multiple faces
until the appearance of
Saurien.

A village



The Molochs





Saurien

is a beast risen from the depths of the earth,
awoken by the folly of man.

He comes to the surface of the earth unleashing his anger.

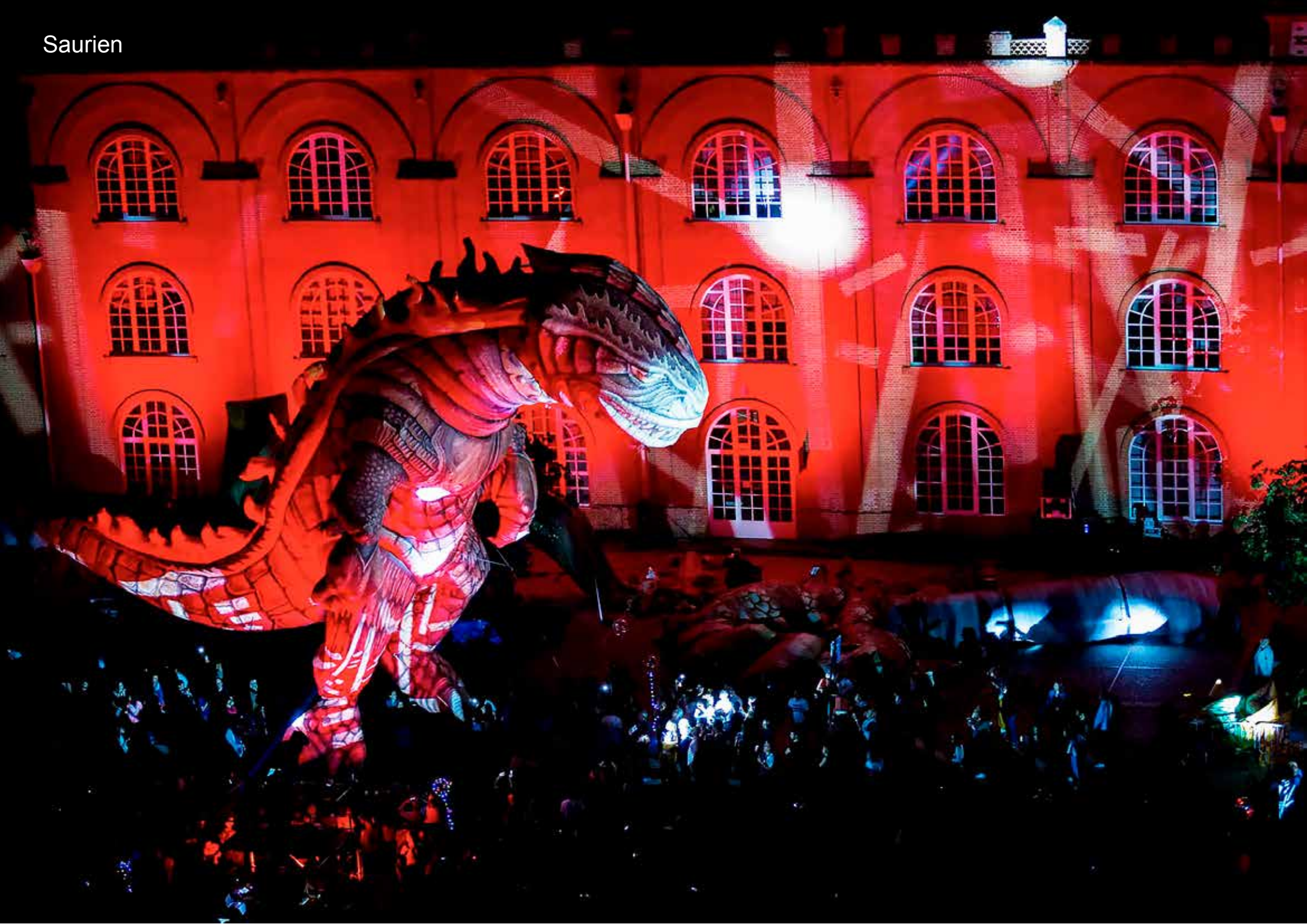
He is going to destroy everything,
crush it all, he is the great catastrophe.

He crosses the village, and the houses flee.

He flattens the chimneys and the Molochs.

When he is at peace,
he goes back to where he came from.

Only

the small people remains,
last survivors of the hardships.

At the call of the music which seems to announce the return of life,
they gather high up, in the center of the space.

Also responding to the call, the fiances of the rain appear,
five tall and colorful silhouettes,
carried by stilt-walkers.

They come closer,
begin a dance where a plant used to be,
and it grows back.

The game repeats and all the vegetation regains it's vitality, rises up.

Once this ritual is achieved,

A giant flower rises above the field, in the middle of the vegetation.

The small people disappear behind the giant colorful bouquet.

The light fades slowly
on this space brought back to life.
